Contingent Leader should be at least 26 years old, appointed by the National Scout Organization (NSO) and can present the WOSM Safe From Harm E-Learning Certificate.

Participants must obtain an endorsement letter from the respective NSO

Have been fully vaccinated and received booster for Covid-19.

Must be in good physical and mental health.

A contingent can include up to 4 patrols of 9 Rovers + 1 Adult Leader
